Skills assessed will tie directly to the grade level expectations created by the state department of education. These grading criteria are designed to give all students equal opportunity to achieve regardless of talent. Projects will be graded with the use of a scoring guide. Typically students will be given a scoring guide through Google Classroom when projects are assigned as to ensure they have the best opportunity possible to be successful.
