

7th Grade Math Syllabus

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Course Description: The goal for 7th Grade Math is for students to...

- (1) Develop understanding of and apply proportional relationships
- (2) Fluently operate with rational numbers
- (3) Work with expressions and equations
- (4) Solve problems involving scale drawing and geometric drawings
- (5) Solve problems involving area, surface area, and volume
- (6) Draw inferences about populations based on samples

Required Supplies:

Students will need to bring: pencils, erasers, binder, binder dividers, and either a spiral notebook or loose leaf paper.

Teacher will provide: markers, colored pencils, crayons, glue, and construction paper

Students **MUST** have their iPads on a daily basis in order to work in class. Students who do not have their iPad will not be able to complete their work. **Not having your iPad or not having it charged so that you can use it will result in consequences lined out in the discipline policy below.**

MAP: Students taking 7th Grade Math are required to take the 7th Grade MAP test at the end of the year. The students score is **worth 15% of the 2nd semester grade.**

Grades: The Re-Assessment Policy states that students will no longer be able to turn in late work. Students however, will have the opportunity to re-assess on any mid-chapter test or chapter test that they score a 79% or less by following the procedures outlined in the re-assessment policy. Students can only earn up to an 80% on any re-assessment and any assignments completed or redone will earn 50% credit.

Competencies (40%): Notes, Homework, and competency checks

Assessments (60%): Mid-Chapter test, Chapter Test, and Finals

Absence Policy: Students who are absent will be required to ask the teacher for the work that they missed while they were gone. This starts immediately upon their return to school and will have the number of days missed to make up the work. After that time, the late assignment policy will go into affect. **So make sure to ask the first day back so you don't lose work time!**

Discipline Policy:

1st Offense: Warning

2nd Offense: 20 minute After-School Detention

3rd Offense: 40 minute After-School Detention

4th Offense: Office Referral

If an offense is severe enough, the student will be sent directly to the office.

Tutoring/Math Help: Students are **ALWAYS** welcome to ask me for tutoring or extra help. They should come to me before/after class and schedule a time to meet with me. This will more than likely take place either before school at 7:45 on MTRF and/or after school until 3:30. If a student needs to go beyond those times after school please let me know. I do have meetings sometimes right after school that may interfere. **Don't forget that we have seminar MTRF that you can get a pass to come to my class to get help, or have a quiet place to work on your math during the school day.**

I have an open door policy for parents! If you need ANYTHING or have a question or concern you may come in before or after school, call me, or email me. My plan period is 6th hour, so if you call during the day it will be during that time or after school.
